At Cebu Beach Club, we understand that many of our guests consider their pets to be part of the family and wish to bring them along on their vacations and staycations. While we are pleased to welcome pet dogs, we are equally committed to ensuring that all guests enjoy a safe, comfortable, clean, and relaxing resort experience. To maintain the highest standards of cleanliness, sanitation, privacy, and guest comfort, Cebu Beach Club welcomes pet dogs only, subject to the following guidelines and conditions:

1. Guests checking in with their dogs are required to register their pets, read and comply with our dog friendly guidelines.
2. Dine-in and day-use guests are requested to keep their dogs away from the pool, beach and guest rooms' area.
3. A pet fee of Php950.00 per dog shall be charged for dogs staying in guest rooms with their handlers or fur parents. A maximum of two (2) dogs only shall be allowed per room.
4. Only small dog breeds with a maximum height of eighteen (18) inches and a maximum weight of twenty (20) kilograms or forty-four (44) pounds are permitted within the resort.
5. Dogs must remain inside their handlers' or fur parents' rooms between 9:00 PM and 8:00 AM. They shall not be left unattended outside the room or in any area of the resort.
6. While in guest-contact areas, dogs must be kept on a leash, in a carrier, or in a crate at all times for their safety and the safety of other guests.
7. Dogs must not be left unattended at any time. A responsible handler or fur parent must always be present to ensure of their dogs' well-being and proper behavior.
8. Dogs are required to wear a diaper or belly band to ensure that marking/dribbling is avoided.
9. When needed, dogs must be accompanied by their handlers/fur parents to relieve themselves, only in designated relief areas. In the event of an accident in a non-designated area, the handler or fur parent shall be responsible for immediately cleaning and sanitizing the affected area.
10. All dogs must have current anti-rabies vaccinations and be up to date with all required immunizations.
11. Handlers or fur parents are responsible for ensuring that their dogs are well-behaved and do not cause excessive noise, disturbances, nuisance, or aggressive behavior toward other guests, staff, or other dogs.
12. Guests checking in with their dogs shall be required to read, acknowledge, and sign the Resort Pet Waiver upon registration.
13. Any damage to resort property, excessive cleaning requirements, or disturbances caused by a pet shall be charged to the registered guest accordingly.
